2. Communication	Demonstrated experience of producing technical documentation.	E
	Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively with a range of colleagues at all levels of seniority.	E

3. Teamwork and Motivation	Ability to work independently and flexibly as part of a team.	E
4. Service Delivery	Ability to understand service and user requirements and to refine system developments according to user feedback.	E
5. Initiative and Problem Solving	A proactive approach and the ability to use initiative in problem-solving, for example investigating and following a problem through to its solution by liaising with appropriate contacts.	E
6. Liaison and Networking	Proven ability to work with colleagues from other parts of an organisation and in external professional networks.	E
